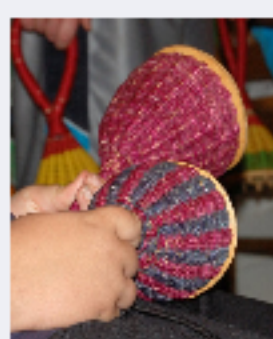

## ***Celebrating Ten Years of Colorful Days....Hephzibah's Summer Arts Enrichment Program.***



For the tenth summer in a row, the Group Homes children were able to immerse themselves in the arts during Hephzibah's Colorful Days Program! From June 22nd through July 13th, visiting artists helped the youngsters express their creativity through various media for two hours every afternoon.



On July 20th the children and their instructors hosted a showcase of their creations to celebrate what they had learned. An exhibit of their work in paper arts and decorative ceramics was displayed in the Art Therapy Room. Musical performances included African Drumming, Harmonica harmonizing, and Singing. The athletic/dance portion of the program included Hip Hop Dance, Double Dutch jump rope techniques, and an Aikido demonstration.

The culmination of the Celebration was a fun yet emotionally charged project for the 26 young residents of the Group Homes. Guided by Hephzibah Art Therapist, Michal Angel, the children worked for several days to create Wish Sticks.



Each child wrote their wish on a small piece of paper which they wrapped around a stick, securing it with colorful strands of yarn. Then they embellished their creation with ribbons and other decorations to make it unique, special and personally meaningful.

When all of the children finished making their Wish Sticks, we moved to the front lawn. The ceremony began as each child took turns (with the help of tall adults) hanging their Wish Stick on the tree. Some children shared their wishes as they hung their stick, others kept their wishes private. When each child rejoined our circle of friends, he was greeted by joyous cheers of support!

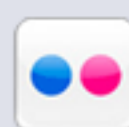
